Assessment Test Definitions:

Special Beginners: Neither handler nor dog having been placed 1st or 2nd in a SB test nor having won any awards in Puppy/Novice/Intermediate/Open test nor won awards at a field trial/shooting dog day. Awards in this class cannot qualify for points towards WSSCSW annual awards.

Puppy: Between 6 and 18 months on day of test.

Novice: Not having been placed 1st twice in Novice in a minor breeds test.
Not having been placed first in an AV Novice test.
Not having been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open or Intermediate stake.
Not having been placed in awards or awarded a COM in a Field Trial.
Not having gained a K.C. Gundog Working Certificate/Show Gundog Working Certificate nor being placed on a Shooting Dog Day.

Intermediate: Any dog qualified to run in a minor breeds test.

Dummies: Must be in canvas in a natural colour (not white/orange) and may be fur or feather-covered. Please note that Intermediate dogs should use full-sized dummies and all dummies must conform to the colour standard.

Exercises: All exercises will be at the discretion of the judges but may include hunting, seen and unseen retrieves. The Special Beginner and Puppy exercises may include walking to heel, steadiness and recall. There may be a water test.

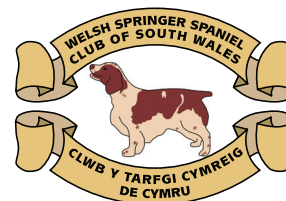
All contestants must be willing to adapt to the judges' set tests.

Would anyone holding a trophy please either bring it with them or arrange for it to be returned to WSSCSW.

Raffle: Raffle prizes would be very much appreciated

Directions: please note that the test will be held on land adjacent to Pentyrch Boarding Kennels CF15 9NP. You can google their directions and watch for last minute signs. Otherwise take Junction 32 M4 then follow A470 signs to Merthyr Tydfil. Once on A470 (approx .75 of a mile) take 1st exit signposted Radyr and Taff's Well. Turn 1st exit left over river bridge and 3rd exit at roundabout ahead signposted Pentyrch. Follow road up hill approx one mile into village of Pentyrch. At T-junction turn right and immediately right again into Mountain Road. Follow this road for approx .75 of a mile and turn sharp left onto Tyn-y-Coed Road, after ¼ mile approx turn right opposite Kennels – signs will be put out. From the west exit M4 at J34, follow signs for Pentyrch, once into Village head for the shops and take Mountain Road, opposite shops and follow as above, or Sat Nav will bring you through Creigiau where you will turn right onto Tyn-y-Coed Road and follow to Kennels.
